-  ITSwisp - *the brainchild of InTouch Systems, a local independent IT solutions provider based in Norwich. They have installed a meshed wireless internet system covering large parts of rural Norfolk including a new mast at Wymondham.*
-  Rural Broadband - *provides Tooway satellite broadband and also the innovative WiBE 3G routers*
-  WiSpire - *is a joint venture between the Diocese of Norwich and a company called FreeClix. Using transmitters and receivers on top of Norfolk churches they can send out broadband signals across the count.*
