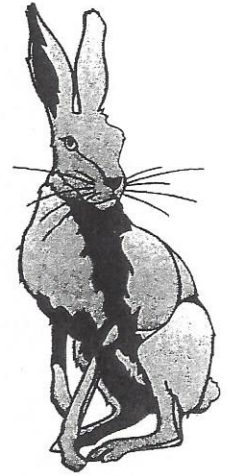

What is a Neighbourhood Plan and what's in it for my business?

A **Neighbourhood Plan** (Neighbourhood Development Plan) is a way of helping local communities to influence the planning of the area in which they live and work.

It can be used to:

- Develop a shared vision for your neighbourhood.
- Choose where new homes, shops, offices and other development should be built and look like.
- Identify and protect important local green spaces and access.
- Influence what new buildings and their surroundings should look like.

Why should your business get involved?

- Good publicity for your business
- Public visibility that you are actively interested in the neighbourhood
- An opportunity to increase community support for development
- A demonstration of corporate and social responsibility
- Access to a network through which to learn more about the area and your customers
- Your employees may also be local residents
- Potential for a closer and more cooperative relationship with the local authority

Watton Town Council is developing a **Neighbourhood Plan 2037** for Watton and has engaged with their local community over recent months to identify an initial series of **Priority Issues** that affect the Town and would like your input into the process. We also would like to know what you want **Watton** to look like and how it should function in **20 years time**.
